



DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

GOD

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is required to receive certification of completion for the Purpose School of Ministry. Any absences need to be cleared with the school and must be made up prior to completion of each session.

COST

Members in good standing who regularly and physically attend the Purpose Church may attend without cost, however, will need to meet all other requirements. All other applicants will need to pay \$200 per quarter. Payment arrangements can be made with a \$50 down payment and payments of \$50 a month for 3 months. Payments must be up to date each month, prior to the beginning of the following month. This cost is non-refundable. Students who pay full amount on the first day will receive a discount of \$25 bringing the cost down to \$225. of Ministry and understand clarification might be made which may be unforeseen.
